## Facts:

**National Language:** French (10% speak it)  
**Common Language:** Haitian Creole, English and Spanish increasingly used as a second language.  
**Economy:** Poorest in Western Hemisphere; 75% live on less than \$2.00 a day. High Crime rate.  
**Capitol:** Port-au-Prince  
**Population (2010):** 10,188,175  
**Area:** Island shared with Dominican Republic.  
**Literacy:** 51.9%

**Fact: Roman Catholicism is the official religion of Haiti, but voodoo may be considered the country's national religion.** The majority of Haitians believe in and practice at least some aspects of voodoo, a development of W. African Spiritism and witchcraft. Most voodooists believe that their religion can coexist with Catholicism. **Pray for revival, repentance and for strong Christian leadership, so many will come to Christ!**
